# Heritage Boulevard Roundabout Construction Notice

**Project Summary**

This project includes the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Heritage Boulevard (CSAH 5) and East Dual Boulevard as well as the reconstruction of Heritage Boulevard from Hwy 65 to the BNSF railroad tracks. The City of Isanti, in conjunction with Isanti County, has awarded this project to ASTECH Corporation.

**Project Schedule**

You can anticipate the following workflow for this project:

- 1) The Roundabout phase of the construction project is scheduled to be completed by October 31, 2025 and the roadway will be open to traffic. The detour route will be removed at this time as well.
- 2) The turn lane into Kwik Trip will be reconstructed starting October 31 and continue to Mid to late November. This entrance and one lane of west bound traffic will be closed for this work.
- 3) Phase 2 of the project will include reconstructing Heritage Boulevard (CSAH 5) from Hwy 65 to the BNSF railroad tracks (connecting into the new roundabout on either side). This work is scheduled to be completed next spring.
  - a. A construction notice will be sent out next year regarding traffic impacts for this phase.

Please note that construction schedules and operations are controlled by the Contractor and are subject to change based on weather and construction progress.
